- Prizes for best scratch (including CPGC Open Cup & Honours Board) and handicap scores.
- No handicap entry restriction however a maximum HI limit of 30 will apply for the handicap competition.
- The kitchen will be open from 7.00am with food available at your own cost.

Visitor entry fee £35.00 - includes discounted green fee, tea / coffee and pastries on arrival.

## Conditions

1. The competitions will be 18-hole Medal (Scratch & Handicap prizes). Scores will be submitted to WHS.
2. Playing partners and tee off times may be requested but final groups, and start times will be allotted by the Club. Players may be allocated a start off either the 1<sup>st</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> tee.
3. Start times will be allocated no later than three days prior to the event and will be posted at the club. Visitors who have supplied an email address will be advised of their start time. Players should aim to arrive at the Club by 7:30am or otherwise MUST ensure they register no later than 30 minutes before their final start time. The first groups will start at 8:00am on first tee and 8:30am off the 10<sup>th</sup> tee
4. Riding in motorised carts is permitted.
5. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
6. In the event of a tie after 18 holes the winner will be determined on countback using the last 9-holes on the course scorecard (holes 10-18) regardless of the starting tee. If the scores are still tied then the last six holes, then the last three holes and finally the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. If there is still a tie, then the same procedure will be applied to the front 9-holes on the course scorecard (holes 1-9).
7. Any practice rounds prior to the event should be arranged through the Club reception. Practice on the course on the day of the competition is not permitted.

## Entries

1. Entries will be accepted only from male amateur golfers with a current WHS HI at the time of the event.
2. There is no handicap entry restriction for the scratch competition, but the number of strokes received for the handicap competition will be based on a maximum HI of 30 or a player's actual HI, whichever is lower.
3. Availability of places is limited and will be allocated on a first come basis.
4. The Entrance Fee is £10.00 for 7-Day CPGC Members and £35 for non-members (including discounted green fee, tea / coffee and pastries on arrival).

3. No player may win more than one main prize.
4. Any additional prizes awarded will be at the discretion of the Committee.
